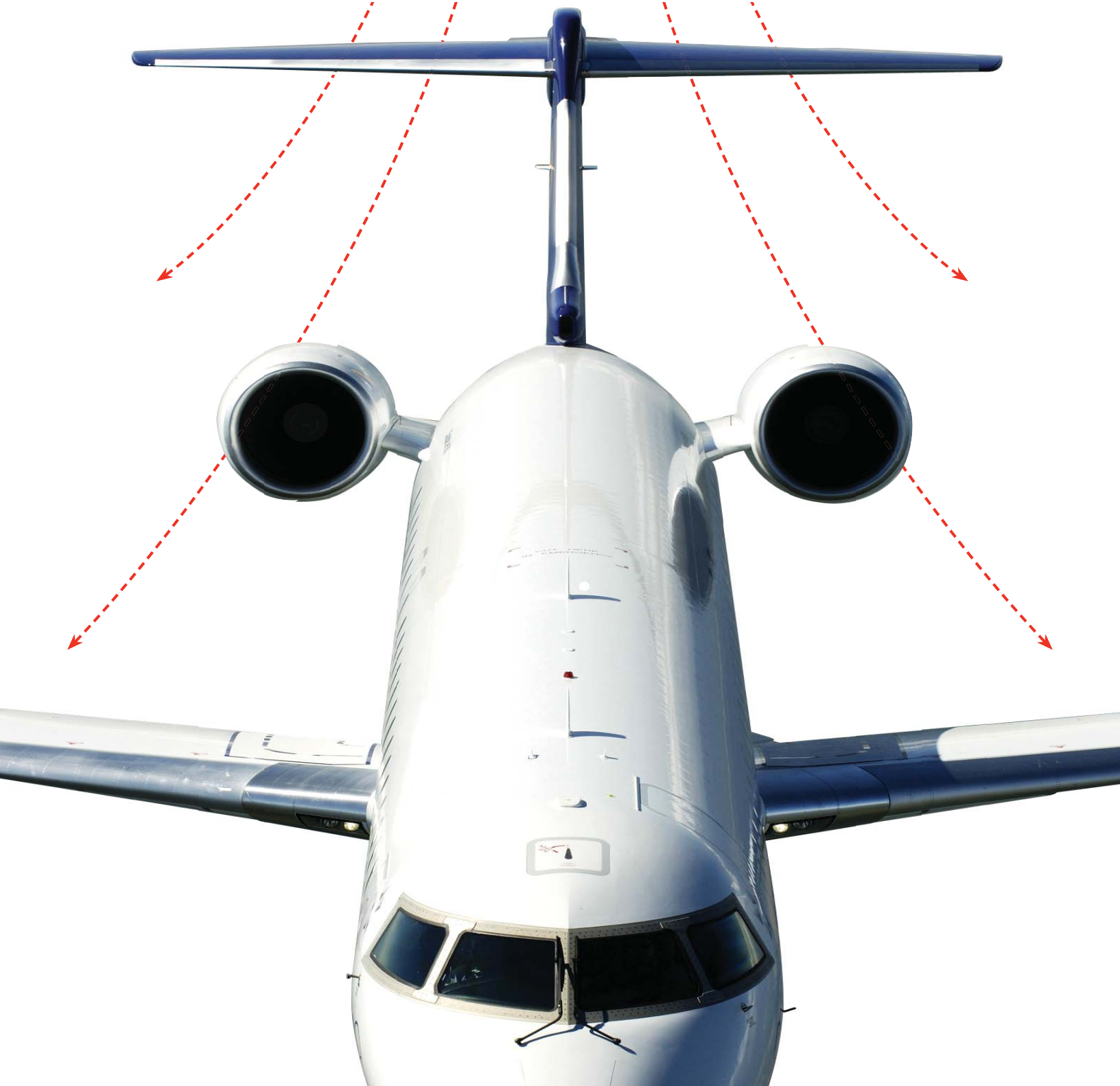

- Home to Bell Helicopter Textron Company, Bombardier, CAE, Pratt & Whitney Canada and OEMs
- Over 50 % of Canadian aerospace companies within just a 30 km radius
- Tax incentives can bring the real cost of \$100 R&D expenditure to as low as \$40
- Location-sensitive costs are significantly lower in Montreal than in other North American major cities (KPMG Competitive Alternatives Study 2008)
- Corporate income tax is the lowest in North America, i.e. 30.9 %
- Tax holiday for foreign researchers for five consecutive years
- Quebec accounts for 70 % of overall R&D spending in the aerospace sector in Canada
- Over 1500 aerospace engineers and researchers, 4 major universities
